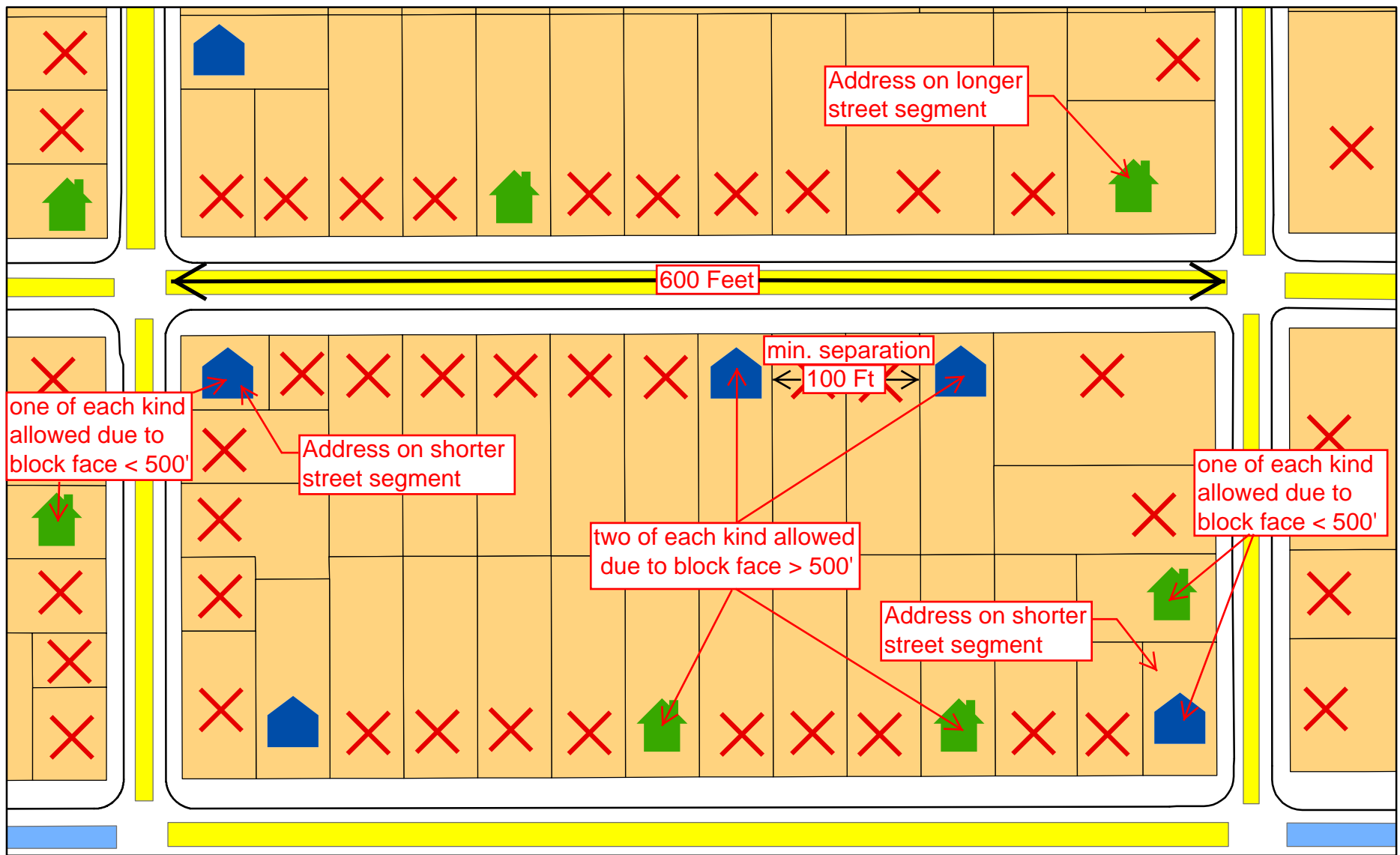
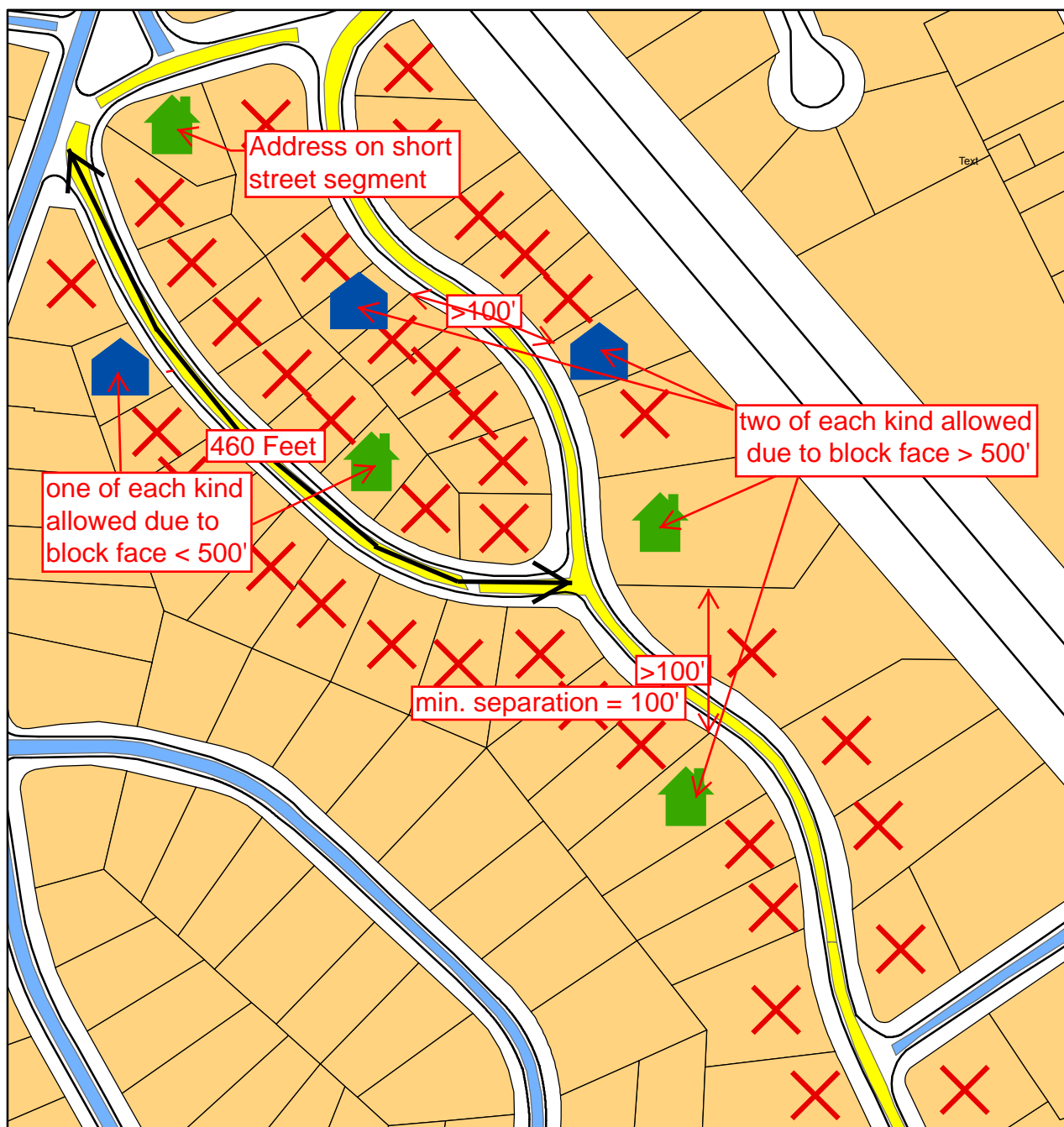








# Street Segment Cap Examples



This illustration shows a proposed method for regulating the proximity of the two types of short-term rental properties. One of each type of rental would be allowed per street segment (block face between intersections), except where block is >500 feet between corners, in which case there may be two per street segment as long as there is at least 100 feet measured horizontally between the property lines of the two Vacation Home Rentals and/or Homestays in the same street segment. Corner houses count on the block face/street of which the address is registered.
