



CITY OF MARQUETTE 2017 SPRING YARD WASTE & BRUSH COLLECTION COMPOST AND HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH INFORMATION

**COMPOST SITE HOURS: Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:00pm – 7:00pm & Saturdays from 9:00am – 4:00pm
CLOSED: Saturday, May 27th; Monday, May 29th; Saturday, July 1st; Monday, July 3rd;
Saturday, Sept 2nd; Monday, Sept 4th**

Properties paying the “Solid Waste” fee on their monthly utility bills (green bag users) are eligible to dispose of yard waste through this collection. Owners and tenants of properties not paying the fee should contact their regular waste hauler for service. This service is supported by **fees, not taxes**. All residents are asked to observe the following rules to provide for a safe, efficient cleanup:

1. These collections are for brush, leaves, grass clippings and garden debris only. **NO** rubbish is allowed. All collected material will be composted. Material is not to be placed more than one week prior to pickup date. **Material MUST be placed curbside prior to 7:00 a.m. of the scheduled pick up date. There will not be a second pick up day for the zones.**
2. Pile yard waste on the lawn next to the street edge, **NOT** in the gutter or on street pavement. Keep yard waste in front of your own property. Do **NOT** pile on vacant adjacent properties. Motorists are asked to avoid parking in positions that block access to leaf piles.
3. Brush pickup will be conducted April 24 – April 28. The brush volume from each property is limited to one pickup load, a pile approx. 12’L x 6’W x 5’H.
4. Crews will collect loose or bagged leaves May 1 - May 12. Do not use City green bags for yard waste. Bags containing garbage or other rubbish mixed with the yard waste will not be collected.
5. Street sweeping and sand pickup will be conducted during leaf collection dates for all residential routes.
6. The City will not collect material after the last date listed below for each route. Residents are asked to deliver it to the composting site on Lakeshore Blvd, one block south of Hawley Street. The site is opening April 24, 2017 for the season. It is open Monday and Wednesday’s 3pm – 7pm and Saturday’s 9am – 4pm. Any yard waste will be accepted but brush will be limited to one pickup load per day. “Solid Waste” fee payment is required for admittance.
7. Open burning is not permitted in the City of Marquette.

Household Rubbish Drop-off Site

Location and Opening: Entrance is off of Wright St. between Presque Isle Ave. and Lakeshore Blvd. The site will open Saturday, April 29, 2017 for the season.

Open to City residents paying the “solid waste” fee on their monthly utility bill: Tuesdays, 3pm-7pm and the second Saturday of each month, 9am – 1pm. An additional date of Saturday, May 6 has been added to the schedule. Site will close November 11, 2017 weather permitting

Users are required to show a driver’s license and a recent City water bill for admittance. The drop-off site is limited to toys, tools, furniture, appliances (must be tagged Freon free), old clothing, shoes, books, drapes, carpets, decorations, remodeling waste (less than one pickup truck load per day) and other minor household item. **No shingles are accepted. Appliances accepted ONLY on Saturdays.**

BRUSH COLLECTION – Brush Only

Monday, April 24 (Zone 1 & 10) – All streets north of Fair Ave.

Tuesday, April 25 (Zone 2 & 4) – East Marquette bounded by & including Front St. on the west, Fair Ave. on the north & Baraga Ave. on the south.

Wednesday, April 26 (Zone 3 & 5) – The area west of Front St. & north of US 41 Bypass bounded by & including Fair Ave. on the north, Seventh St. on the west.

Thursday, April 27 (Zone 6 & 7) – All streets south of US 41 Bypass

Friday, April 28 (Zone 8 & 9) – The area west of Seventh St. & north of US 41 Bypass bounded by & including Fair Ave. on the north.

COMPOST COLLECTION – Leaves, grass clippings and garden debris

Monday, May 1 (Zone 1) – Area bounded by Tracy & Sugarloaf on the west and lying north of Fair

Tuesday, May 2 (Zone 2) – Area bounded by & including E. Fair Ave. on the north, E. Hewitt Ave. on the south & N. Front St. on the west.

Wednesday, May 3 (Zone 3) – Area west of N. Front St. bounded by & including W. Hewitt Ave. on the south & Seventh St. on the west.

Thursday, May 4 (Zone 4) – Area south of E. Hewitt Ave., bounded by & including E. Baraga Ave. on the south & Front St. on the west.

Friday, May 5 (Zone 5) – Area south of W. Hewitt Ave., north of US 41 Bypass, west of Front St. & bounded by & including Seventh St. on the west.

Monday, May 8 (Zone 6) – Area south of US 41 Bypass, bounded by & including Hampton St. on the south.

Tuesday, May 9 (Zone 7) – Area south of Hampton St.

Wednesday, May 10 (Zone 8) – Area north of US 41 Bypass, west of Seventh St. bounded by & including Cleveland Ave. on the north.

Thursday, May 11 (Zone 9) – Area north of Cleveland Ave. west of N. Seventh St. bounded by & including W. Fair Ave. on the north.

Friday, May 12 (Zone 10) – Area north of W. Fair Ave. & west of NMU Campus.
