

HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH DROP-OFF SITE LOCATION-WRIGHT ST.

(BETWEEN PRESQUE ISLE & LAKESHORE BLVD)

Properties paying the "Garbage/Yard Waste" fee on their monthly utility bills (green bag users) are eligible to utilize the following drop-off site. Owners and tenants of properties not paying the fee should contact their regular waste hauler for service. This site is supported by **user fees, not taxes.**

Regular site days and times are every Tuesday beginning April 26 with hours from 3 pm-7 pm and the second (2nd) Saturday of the month 9 am-1 pm. The site will also be open Saturday, April 30. The site will close at 1 pm Saturday November 12 for the season. Entrance to the site located off of Wright Street between Lakeshore Blvd. and Presque Isle Ave.

A City water utility bill with garbage fee and Driver's License will be required for admittance. You must sign in with the attendant as you enter the site. Residents in rental units using the "green bags" who do not have a utility bill in their name need to contact their landlord to file a form with the Public Works Dept. with a list of tenants eligible to use the site. HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH DROP-OFF

The drop-off is limited to toys, tools, furniture, (appliances Freon free must be tagged), old clothing, shoes, books, draperies, carpets, decorations, (remodeling waste less than one pickup truck load per day), and other minor household items. **NO SHINGLES ARE ACCEPTED.** Acceptable material limited to one (1) pickup load per day. This drop-off site is not available to commercial haulers.

REMODELING WASTE

If you are doing major remodeling or re-roofing your house contact Waste Management, North Country Disposal or Great American Disposal to set up a dumpster service on site.

APPLIANCES & WHITE GOODS

Appliances accepted only on Saturdays. Appliances and White Goods include all appliances, and water heaters. Appliances using any regulated refrigerant must bear an appropriate technician's certificate of compliance certifying that the refrigerant has been recaptured.

METAL ITEMS

Metal items will be separated for recycling.

ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

Certain TV'S, computers and their peripherals can be recycled at the following locations:

Following items not accepted:

- Liquid or hazardous wastes
- Freon containing appliances
- Brush or yard wastes.
- Regular garbage, including food items.
- Electronic Equipment (TV's, Computers, Laptops, Network Equipment, Computer Parts, Software, Flat-panel Screens, Monitors, Printers and Scanners).
- Rocks or masonry
- Compressed gas tanks
- Tires
- Shingles
