Mattson Park Lift Station Replacement Project

Beginning at 7:00 a.m. on Monday March 26th construction will start on the Mattson Park Lift Station Replacement Project and continue until the middle of May. During this project citizens should have full access and Mattson Park will remain open. Construction activities will be concentrated on a line from the northwest corner of the park over to the parking lot north of the children's play area and then through the parking lot over to near the marina building. The marina building will remain open. However, it is anticipated that for a short while sanitary service to the marina building and fish cleaning station will be unavailable. The concession building and children's play area will remain open.

A temporary construction fence will isolate construction activity from the children's play area. In the parking lot, construction activity will also be bordered by a temporary construction fence. Vehicles will have access to the south side of the parking lot from either the west or east end at all times.

Smith Paving is the general contractor for this project.
