PRESQUE ISLE PARK PLAYGROUND

Be a part of the planning for a new inclusive playground for Presque Isle Park!

City of Marquette invites the participation of all interested community members in the planning and design of an inclusive playground facility for Presque Isle Park. The new facility will replace the existing playground at the park.

“This project has been in the discussion stage for some time”, said PIPAC Chairman Bob Chapman. “The vision for this facility, so far, is that it will be an inclusive play area that will provide another reason for families to enjoy Marquette’s crown jewel, Presque Isle Park”, he said.

The City is seeking an inclusive design that will be completely accessible and can be enjoyed by children of all ages and abilities, regardless of special needs, physical and cognitive disabilities.

To participate in the planning for the new playground, citizens are encouraged to attend a public open house and presentation scheduled for Wednesday, December 5, 2012, from 6-8pm, at the Presque Isle Pavilion. There will be a short presentation at 7pm, and will be supported by displays and photos depicting play areas and play equipment options.
