STREET DISRUPTIONS
SANITARY SEWER SLIP LINING PROJECT
IN THE CITY OF MARQUETTE**



Beginning the week of Monday August 6, 2012 various areas in the City of Marquette will experience traffic disruptions due to sanitary sewer slip lining operations. Insituform Technologies will be incorporating trenchless technology by the use of a slip lining process to replace the sanitary sewer mains. The public is advised to use caution when traveling through these areas and be aware of all traffic control. Work will be continuing for the next three weeks at the following locations:

Anderson Street - Garden Street to Homestead Street
Division Street - Furnace Street to Hogan's Alley
Hancock Street - Sheridan Street to Dead End
Hogan's Alley - Book Street to Division Street
Jefferson Street - Garfield Avenue to Bike Path
Norway Avenue - North of Waldo Street to Center Street
West Ridge Street - Rublein Street to McClellan Avenue
Sherman Street - Garfield Avenue to Bike Path
Wright Street - Gray Street to Lincoln Avenue
Wright Street - Sugarloaf Avenue to Old Rail Road Grade E. of Presque Isle Avenue
