WASHINGTON STREET CLOSURES AND DISRUPTIONS DUE TO STREET AND TRAFFIC SIGNAL WORK ACTIVITIES

Beginning at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, September 30, 2013, Washington Street will experience street disruptions and closures due to street and traffic signal work activities by Associated Constructors. Washington Street and Lincoln Avenue intersection traffic will be restricted to one lane each direction. Washington Street signals will be flashing yellow during this time. There will be no turning onto Lincoln Avenue from Washington Street. Lincoln Avenue will be closed to through traffic from Bluff Street to Washington Street. The detour route for Lincoln Avenue will be by way of Bluff Street, Rublein Street, and Seymour Avenue. The opening of Lincoln Avenue is scheduled for October 19, 2013 pending any unforeseen delays. The completion of the new traffic signal configuration is estimated to be in 8-10 weeks.

Businesses will be open during the construction work and have access from Washington Street.

The public is advised to be aware of all flagging, detours, advisory signing, and traffic control devices and to use caution when traveling through these areas.
