3:00 p.m. - Lakeshore Boulevard from Mattson Park to Baraga Avenue

5:00 p.m. - Lakeshore Boulevard from Baraga Avenue to U.S. 41

5:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. - The northbound lane of S. Lake Street from U.S. 41 to Hampton Street

5:15 p.m. - Front Street from Baraga Avenue to Bluff Street
