WASHINGTON STREET CLOSURES AND DISRUPTIONS DUE TO WATER MAIN/SERVICE REPAIRS FOR THE STREET MILL AND OVERLAY PROJECT

Beginning at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, August 12, 2013 Washington Street will experience street and water disruptions and closures due to water main and service work for the upcoming mill and overlay project by Payne and Dolan. There will be three different phases of water main and service work from the limits of U.S. 41 to Garfield Avenue. Businesses will be open during the construction work. Phasing, dates of work, and detour routes are as follows:

Phase 1

Monday, August 12, 2013 at 7:00 a.m. to Tuesday, August 13, 2013 at 7:00 a.m.
Washington Street will be closed to through traffic from Garfield Avenue to Rublein Street
Detour route will be by means of Garfield Avenue, Bluff Street, and Rublein Street

Phase 2

Wednesday, August 14, 2013 at 7:00 a.m. to Thursday, August 15, 2013 at 7:00 a.m.
West bound traffic on Washington Street will be closed to through traffic from McClellan Avenue to Meeske Avenue. Detour route will be by means of McClellan Avenue, Ridge Street, and Meeske Avenue.
East bound traffic on Washington will be reduced to one lane by the use of lane shifting.

Phase 3

Monday, August 19, 2013 at 7:00 a.m. to Tuesday, August 20, 2013 at 7:00 a.m.
Washington Street will be closed to through traffic from McClellan Avenue to Rublein Street
Detour route will be by means of McClellan Avenue, Ridge Street, and Rublein Street

The public is advised to be aware of all flagging, detours, advisory signing, and traffic control devices and to use caution when traveling through these areas.
