ABOUT THE CONDUCTORS

Dr. Stephen Grugin is completing his third year as Director of the Marquette City Band. Now in his eighteenth year as the Director of Bands and Professor of Low Brass at Northern Michigan University, Dr. Grugin brings his exceptional leadership and experience to the Marquette City Band and to the Upper Peninsula Community Band Festival. His creative ideas and tremendous energy have been engaged in every aspect of this festival. Dr. Grugin holds degrees in music from The Ohio State University, Northwestern University, and Florida State University, and is well established as a conductor, music educator, and trombone performer.

D. Keith Lawson conducts the Negaunee City Band, which is currently in its 114th year. A native of Ishpeming, he received both his bachelors and master's degrees in Music Education from Northern Michigan University and also attended Michigan State. After 18 years teaching music in the public schools, both in the U.P. and in downstate Michigan, he returned to NMU earning a degree in Computer Information Systems with a Business Administration minor. He has worked in the sales area and also served as the Executive Director of Peninsula Arts Appreciation Council (PAAC) where he continually strove to bring in new arts of all forms to our area. He brings a wealth of experience to the festival, having been involved as a player and conductor in the city bands of Ishpeming, Marquette and Negaunee for nearly 60 years!

The Marquette City Band is a leader among regional community bands with a membership of about eighty musicians each year. It draws instrumentalists from as far as outlying areas of Marquette County, Escanaba and Munising, even though many of these members also play in bands in their own communities. The band has a well-established heritage, celebrating in 2012 the 125th anniversary of its formation in 1887. Summer concerts have been performed continuously every year since 1929, funded largely by taxpayers through the City of Marquette. Each summer there are seven concerts, including those at the Presque Isle Band Shell, the Fourth of July celebration in the Lower Harbor, and a Sunday afternoon concert for the children at Bay Cliff Health Camp. Winter and spring concerts have recently been added to the performance schedule. The band is very popular with a strongly committed following represented in audiences of 200-400 at typical concerts and even more on special occasions.
