9:00 a.m. - Fourth Street from Spring Street to Bluff Street

1:00 p.m. - Lakeshore Boulevard from Mattson Park to Baraga Avenue

5:00 p.m. - Lakeshore Boulevard from Baraga Avenue to U.S. 41

5:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. - The northbound lane of S. Lake Street from U.S. 41 to Hampton Street

5:15 p.m. - Front Street from Baraga Avenue to Bluff Street

5:45 p.m. - Third Street from Spring Street to Bluff Street

The Front Street detour route for the Friday street closures will be via Front Street, Baraga Avenue, Fifth Street, Bluff Street, Front Street.
