The City of Marquette would like to announce all City arts and culture organizations and schools that received grants from the Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs. Council members announced Dec. 19 that City organizations were awarded \$241,461. Grants awarded locally were:

County Recipients include Gwinn Area Community Schools with \$3,250 and the Iron Ore Heritage Recreation Authority with \$10,000. Last year the MCACA awarded \$7.6 million (\$196,750 - Marquette County) to arts and cultural organizations and this year \$9.7 million was awarded, a 27% increase.
