### **HAWLEY STREET MULTI-USE PATHWAY EXTENSION PROJECT BEGINS**

At 7 a.m. on Tuesday, July 7, construction will begin on the Hawley Street multi-use pathway extension project. This project will span from Wilkinson Street to the Dead River Bridge on the north side of Hawley Street. The pathway will be located south of the ball and soccer fields and, when complete, will add 2,400 feet of additional pathway to the City's public system.

There will be times when access to the Kaufman Sports Complex from Hawley Street will be disrupted and/or closed to traffic to allow for construction of the pathway. Other public service announcements will advise when this is the case.

This project is being funded by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and the City of Marquette, and is scheduled to be substantially complete by Aug. 15.

The public is advised to use caution when traveling through this area and to be alert for construction and advisory signing.

Smith Paving, Inc. is the general contractor for this project.
