“SUZAN PITT at CITY HALL” EXHIBITION

The City of Marquette Arts & Culture Center announces an exhibition of paintings by artist Suzan Pitt on the walls of City Hall, 300 West Baraga Ave.

Pitt’s acrylic on canvas mural “*Woodland*” spans a spectacular seventeen feet with a height of five feet and is installed along the main hallway leading to the City Manager’s Suite. Watercolors of the native plants and forests of Marquette County are displayed throughout the area including the City Manager’s office.

Although she resides in Los Angeles, internationally acclaimed filmmaker and artist Suzan Pitt summers in the Upper Peninsula where she uses her artistic connection to the outdoors to fuel her art making. Pitt’s local themes are sure to interest and inspire Marquette Residents.
