POLAR ROLL SNOW BIKE RACE SET FOR SATURDAY IN MARQUETTE

There will be a 15-mile and 35-mile snow bike race in Marquette on Saturday, Feb. 20.

The 15-mile race will start on the multi-use path east of US41 and proceed west over US41 and cross Wilson Street at the Harlow Farms subdivision. The first bike is expected to cross Wilson Street at approximately 11:03 a.m. with a continuous stream of bikes crossing Wilson Street until approximately 11:20 a.m. Drivers should expect to be delayed during this time and are encouraged to travel alternative routes.

The 15-mile race will leave the City limits and then re-enter the City from the west along with the 35-mile race. Both races will enter the City on trails and then proceed on to Cliffs Power Road approximately ¼ mile west of US41 from approximately 11 a.m. to noon.

The bicyclists will proceed east on Cliffs Power Road to Lake Street, then proceed north on Lake Street to South Beach, at which point the bicyclists will proceed on the multi-use path to the finish at Elwood A. Mattson Park at the Lower Harbor, with the last bicyclist expected to finish at approximately 5 p.m.

No City streets will be closed for this event, however vehicles could be delayed for up to 20 minutes on Wilson Street at the Harlow Farms subdivision and drivers are encouraged to travel an alternate route. Motorists are advised to be cautious and courteous of bicyclists on Cliffs Power Road and Lake Street.
