SENIOR CENTER TO OFFER AARP SMART DRIVING CLASS

AARP's Smart Driving course is a refresher course designed specifically to meet the needs of drivers over the age of 50. The course covers age-related physical changes, declining perception skills, rules of the road, local driving problems and license renewals. It is specially designed to help older citizens continue driving safely.

The two-part class will take place in the Citizens Forum Room at Lakeview Arena, located at 401 E. Fair Ave., on May 24 and 25 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. (lunch break from noon to 1 p.m.).

The instructor will be Don Balmer, a retired public school teacher who taught Driver's Education for over 30 years and who is certified to teach the AARP Driving Classes. There is a \$15 fee for AARP members, \$20 for non-members, and the fee is for AARP's text book, handout materials and video.
