

City of Marquette Presque Isle

Presque Isle is Marquette's "crown jewel". "The Island", as it is referred to, contains over 323 acres of scenic park land. The park supports over 100 native plants and numerous species of wild animals and birds. The park's diverse landscapes including pebble beaches, rocky cliffs, bogs and forest can be viewed from Peter White Drive or enjoyed while walking along its many interior hiking trails. Presque Isle Park also includes a band shell, tennis courts, playgrounds, picnic areas, a gazebo and an enclosed pavilion. During the winter Peter White Drive and the park's interior trails are open for snowshoeing and cross country skiing. As you enjoy the park, please take only pictures and leave only foot prints.
